St Ippolyts (Ippollitts) Local History Group

The Group was formed in 1990. It aims to promote an understanding and respect for the civil parish and where possibly display, publish and print items for present and future generations to enjoy.

The group carry out research into the history of the civil parish and current projects include transcribing the parish registers. They record changes taking place today in the locality as part of the Hertfordshire Association for Local History's Recorder Scheme. They monitor planning applications and policy. They enter community events when requested into the Comet, Town and Around courtesy of the local paper. They publish books, leaflets and give guided walks.
